Annual UFO Festival

Save the date for Friday and Saturday, May 19 and 20, when McMenamins Hotel Oregon will host the 7th Annual UFO Festival that explores and celebrates the possibilities of life

beyond Earth. We are honored to feature Jesse Marcel, Jr., as our keynote speaker. Marcel's father was the first official on the 1947 Roswell, New Mexico, UFO crash site. His son, Jesse Marcel, Jr. (our speaker), is the only individual acknowledged by the U.S. government to have handled and analyzed the debris found in the wreckage. Marcel is the author of the newly released Roswell: It Really Happened, an account of the incident, his family's involvement and the subsequent government cover-up. The book is generating great buzz in the ufology community and beyond; Marcel has chosen to launch his work at the festival. We'll also host a workshop on the evolution of ufology, moderated by Peter Davenport, director of the National UFO Reporting Center in Seattle.
